

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND OF IBHA, INC.

In 1987 a scholarship program was devised to be a separate not for profit corporation under the auspices of the registry. The corporation is dedicated to support the continued education of outstanding young people actively involved in IBHA. Monetary scholarships are awarded to help deserving young members pursue their educational goals through college or vocational programs.

The first scholarships, totaling \$2,000.00, were awarded in 1988. As of the year 2008, the Youth Scholarship Fund has awarded over \$148,500.00. Scholarships are renewable for a period not to exceed four consecutive years.

Live and silent auctions, held at the National Convention and World Championship Show, are a major source of raising funds for the scholarship program. In addition, other fund raising projects include sales of the official IBHA hat, sales of prints of the Orren Mixer painting "the Buckskin", donations from individuals and IBHA Charter Clubs as well as periodic fund raising ideas such as the 2001 "Kiss the Pig" contest. All proceeds from the sale items go directly to the scholarship program. Celebrities such as James Drury (the Virginian), Sonny Shroyer (Enos), Christine Paine, Dale Robertson, Sheb Wooley, Ben Johnson, Mike Moroff and Chuck Connors to name a few, have donated items and in some cases made personal appearances at the Scholarship Auctions to aid in the fund raising efforts of IBHA.

Commissioned in 1996 and completed in 1998, "the Buckskin" was unveiled at the 1998 IBHA World Championship Show. The painting depicts 19 horses. The buckskin stallion and his band of 9 mares and 9 foals reveal the various shades of the buckskin, dun, red dun and grulla horses accepted for IBHA registration. The limited edition of 100 artist remarques were sold at the unveiling of the painting and are now only available from private individuals. There are some of the 400 numbered and autographed prints (22"X28") available from IBHA (see form below) and from the AQHA Heritage Center and Museum in Amarillo. The original painting can be viewed at the AQHA Heritage Center where it is on display as a loan from the scholarship fund,

IBHA commissioned Darrell Sullivan of Las Cruces, New Mexico to personally hand craft each IBHA hat. A master hatter, Mr Sullivan is a 3rd generation hat maker.

A top of the line 30X beaver fur hat is being offered in “buckskin” color only. A 20X beaver fur is available in platinum and black colors. All sizes are available in regular and long oval. The hats are made exclusive for IBHA. Proceeds of the sale of the hats go to the IBHA Youth Scholarship Fund.

The 20X hats sell for \$265.00 plus \$10.00 shipping. The 30X hats sell for \$295.00 plus \$10.00 shipping. The hats compare to \$385.00 and \$470.00 prices of major brand name manufactured hats.
